ORGANIZATION

Founded in 2011, NubAbility® Athletics Foundation has grown to provide limb-different children with coaching in 23 mainstream organized sports at camps and clinics across the United States. When children overcome athletic challenges during camp, they gain courage and confidence to apply in other areas of their lives.

PROGRAMS

Starting with its first camp in 2012, NubAbility has served 2,200 limb-different children at more than 75 sports camps and clinics in 17 states. NubAbility provides visibility for limb-different children's accomplishments under the hashtag #DontNeed2 on social media.

CONSTITUENCY SERVED

Programs are open to children with congenital or traumatic loss of one or more limbs ages 4 to 17; seventy-five percent of campers receive scholarships. Past camps have drawn participants from 49 states and 11 foreign countries.

LEADERSHIP

Executive Director Sam Kuhnert founded NubAbility at the age of 17 to encourage limb-different children like himself to get off the bench and into organized sports. One hundred twenty volunteer coaches with limb loss offer instruction, inspiration and ongoing mentorship at camps.
