ORGANIZATION

A division of NubAbility® Athletics Foundation, NubAbility Outdoors helps limb-different children gain courage, confidence and a greater appreciation of the outdoors through instruction in outdoor sports and skills. Events are led by volunteer limb-different instructors who are themselves lifelong outdoorsmen.

PROGRAMS

Starting with a shooting camp in 2016, NubAbility has offered 19 outdoors camps in eight states, including 3D archery, competitive shooting, deep sea fishing and snow goose, whitetail deer and wild hog hunts. The organization also offers a full day of outdoors programming each year at its flagship NubAbility Athletics All Sports Camp.

CONSTITUENCY SERVED

Programs are open to children with congenital or traumatic loss of one or more limbs ages 4 to 17; seventy-five percent of campers receive scholarships.

LEADERSHIP

Executive Director Sam Kuhnert founded NubAbility at the age of 17 to encourage limb-different children like himself to get off the couch and into organized sports and outdoor activities.

CREDENTIALS

All hunting and shooting instructors are range safety officer-certified by the NRA.

NubAbility is located in Du Quoin, IL and operates camps nationwide.
